- ❖ Have a pattern that fits you and textiles and accessories at the ready. If you already have a dress and want to make small adjustments and alterations we will be happy to guide you. However, if you want to make more advanced alterations to your dress, we cannot guarantee that we will be able to help you.
- ❖ Are aware that the responsibility for the dress and materials lies with you as user of the workshop. We can guide and help you reach your goal, but we cannot take responsibility for your dress living up to your expectations.
- ❖ Know that we are here to help and guide you as well as the other users of the workshop. We do our best to attend to your needs, but we will need to be attentive to everyone, and therefore each user cannot expect to get the full attention of our employees or a certain employee. How much time we have for each individual user and their project depends on the number of employees at work and the number of users present at the workshop at a given time.
